The Baku-Tbilisi-Ceyhan pipeline in Turkey and Georgia is a case in point. After conducting detailed vegetation mapping along the pipeline Right of Way and identifying threatened species in the project area, we documented all data, put processes in place, devised plans and mobilised resources. Only then did we start construction, during which we made sure of barricading key areas, controlling erosion and training our staff in environmental practices.

We also initiated innovative waste management practices, took care to preserve the topsoil and re-contoured the project land with the help of bio-restoration activities. Two months were all we had to do this, for that was the interval between the migration and breeding periods of the rare flora and fauna species. Finally, we were successful in reinstating the Zamanti River and its tributaries.
